



SALDANHA BAY MUNICIPALITY WATER RESTRICTIONS

A 20% water restriction limit will be imposed to all water consumers. The following tariff increases (as per table below) will be applied on accounts and will be processed as from 1 November 2016.

Water restriction measures applicable to all consumers:

1. Watering (with drinking water from municipal supply) of gardens, flower beds, sport fields, parks, lawns and other open spaces will be allowed on a Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday between 18:00 - 07:00.
2. Washing of vehicles (including recreational vehicles and watercrafts) is only allowed with hosepipes fitted with automatic self-closing devices, or with waterless products.
3. No washing or hosing down of hard-surfaced or paved areas with drinking water from a tap.
4. Informal car washes are to use only buckets and not hosepipes.
5. If alternative water sources (e.g. boreholes, well points, grey water re-use, treated effluent water, spring water and rain water harvesting) are utilised, all customers must ensure that they display appropriate signage at the entrance of their property.
6. No automatic top-up systems are allowed for swimming pools. It is recommended that all swimming pools be covered by a pool cover to avoid evaporation when not in use.

How can the community help the Municipality to save water?

1. Reduce your daily water consumption by 20%.
2. Report water wastage and vandalism of municipal water infrastructure to 022701 7061.
3. Repair water leaks at home.
4. Share water saving tips with neighbours, friends and colleagues.

How Saldanha Bay Municipality will help to save water:

1. Through the implementation of water demand management and water conservation initiatives.
2. Special efforts will be made to repair water leaks where poorer (RDP) households are not in a position to carry the repair cost.
3. The restriction measures applicable to all consumers will be enforced by Law Enforcement.
4. Saldanha Bay Municipality will comply with the 20% water savings in our own usage.
